Introduction

Business Integrity Forum of Transparency International Italia proposes a BIF Side Activity 2024 dedicated to the theme of Business Ethics and Sustainability, with different experiences to understand and stimulate, to convey ideas and realise projects, ambitions, results.

The event aims to provide an overview of the new challenges of corporate compliance in the field of sustainability, starting with the European Union's Corporate Sustainability Directive (CSRD), which came into force in January 2023, and ending with the human and environmental rights issues contained in the Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence Directive (CSDD), recently adopted by the European Parliament with the aim of promoting sustainable and responsible corporate behaviour.

The Corporate Sustainability Directive requires European companies to disclose the impact of their activities on the environment and people and, at the same time, to share the consequences of their environmental, social and governance (ESG) actions on the company's performance and results.

The Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence Directive aims to promote sustainable and responsible corporate behaviour by ensuring that companies identify and take action to mitigate the negative impacts of their business on human and environmental rights, at European and international level.

When defining specific policies on sustainability issues, the fight against active and passive corruption occupies a prominent place, to the extent that business integrity implicitly becomes a guarantee of soundness and embodies one of the company's main values.
